## Discipleship Courses

### Discipleship 101/102 – Following Jesus

Sundays 1 - 4 pm, January 19 - April 5 (with a few Sundays off)

Teacher: Pastor David Zier · Fee: \$40, includes workbook

This is our flagship course that we encourage everyone in our congregation to take at one point or another. In this course, we will take a deep dive into what it means to be a follower of Jesus, experiment with different ways of praying and engaging the Bible, explore what it means to be part of a church community, and make some wonderful new friends in the process! As an added bonus, once you've completed this course, you're eligible to become a voting member of LifeJourney if you wish.

### Jesus & Me (Kids Discipleship Class)

Tuesdays 6:30 - 8:00 pm, January 28 - February 25

Teacher: Pastor Chris Edwards · Fee: \$20, includes materials

Jesus & Me is a five-week course in a larger series designed to teach children the basics of faith, much like a catechism class. In this course we explore Jesus as Storyteller, Teacher, Friend, and Healer. This is the same material used for a variety of scout organizations for their merit badges, but you do not have to be in scouts to participate. This particular course is targeted at children in Kindergarten - 2nd Grade, and is designed for parents to attend with their children. The deadline for signing up is January 19, but those who sign up early will be able to begin the course with their own copy of the materials.

## Board Election Notice

At our 2020 Annual Congregational Meeting, we will elect four members to our Board of Directors, each for a three-year term. Those positions have been filled by Genese Parker, Robert Ferguson, Graham Melendez, and Tina Sherrard. Genese, Robert, and Graham are willing to stand for reelection, but Tina had to step down recently due to unexpected life circumstances.

Under our Bylaws, the Board is responsible for creating a Nominating Committee before each election to ensure at least one outstanding candidate is available for each position. The Bylaws provide that the Nominating Committee shall consist of the Senior Pastor, one Board member (Tim Paschal), and two other church leaders who are not Board members. When selecting those two additional members of the Nominating Committee, the Board looks for leaders who know lots of people within the church and have not served on the Committee recently, so as to promote diversity of perspectives. This year Andrea Platt and Louann Daniels have agreed to serve on the Committee.

The Nominating Committee will canvass for interest, review all individuals who express interest, then prepare nominations. To stand for election, you must be a church member for at least 6 months, be regular in worship attendance, and be a regular giver. Board members are expected to attend regular monthly meetings (second Tuesday evening of each month) and to serve in various functions of church governance. Important qualities include: spiritual depth, collegial attitude, and strategic thinking. Tina Sherrard was in line to become the next Treasurer of our Board. With her position vacant, the Nominating Committee will especially be looking for someone with the experience and willingness to fulfill that critical role.
