Amazing Work at Dayspring!

Last Saturday, in a single day, an amazing crew of LifeJourney volunteers painted all 14 family apartments at the Dayspring Center for Homeless Families. Meanwhile, another crew of LifeJourney volunteers prepared and served breakfast that morning to the families, as happens almost every Saturday. A heartfelt thanks to all our wonderful volunteers!!



Church Renovations & Church Finances

Our bank has approved our \$300k Capital Improvements Loan! In the weeks ahead, as the weather breaks, you'll see amazing changes to our building. We'll begin by replacing the exterior wood siding and gutters. After that, we will build larger, code-compliant restrooms, then repave the main parking lot!

Meanwhile, we now have two months under our belt in 2019. A quick financial analysis shows that our giving declined in January and February by almost \$1,000 per week. *Yikes!* The decline is due to the end of our big push to meet our bank's 2018 financial goals, a few people who've not been able to carry forward their fall pledges, lots of snow that has kept people away on Sundays, and the loss of a couple significant givers who moved out-of-state.

If you're not yet a regular giver to LifeJourney, now would sure be a great time to begin! If you're already a regular giver, but feel called to increase your giving, that too would be awesome. Regular giving in any amount makes a powerful difference. We're not going to make a big deal out of this. 



Journey Through the Bible


