**APRIL 14-21** 

**Palm Sunday,** Today at 9:30 am & 11:00 am Sunday Worship services today mark the beginning of Holy Week, the last week of Jesus' Life.

### Maundy Thursday, Thursday at 7:00 pm

Join us for an actual meal together reenacting the Last Supper in a manner consistent with the authentic Jewish Seder Tradition. Seating is limited; reserve your place by completing the response form.

### Good Friday, Friday at 7:00 pm

This year's Good Friday Service will be unlike any before—a dramatic production, wrapped in sacred music. The dramatic portion of the service, a brief play called, "The Passion: On Trial," will place Christ's crucifixion and resurrection on trial in a modern-day courtroom setting, with flashbacks to the original events. The trial will conclude in a brief dramatic segment at Easter Sunday worship.

### Last Day: Reserve Your Lily

Often called the "white-robed apostles of hope," lilies were found growing in the Garden of Gethsemane after Christ's agony. Tradition has it that the beautiful white lilies sprung up where drops of Christ's sweat fell to the ground in his final hours of sorrow and deep distress. Churches continue this tradition at Easter time by banking their alters and surrounding their crosses with masses of Easter Lilies, to commemorate the resurrection of Jesus Christ and hope of life everlasting.



If you would like to commemorate this tradition and/or honor someone special this Easter, please reserve your personal Easter Lily for Easter Sunday. (After service, you can take home your Lily.)
