Interested in a Medical Missions Trip?

LifeJourney's Global Outreach Board is in the early stages of exploring the feasibility of organizing a medical missions trip to either Guatemala or Haiti in the next year or two. Historically, our missions trips have focused on construction projects. For example, next month we'll be sending a team to the Appalachian Mountains to renovate homes for impoverished families, and we're planning to send a construction team back to Guatemala June 13-21, 2020. But we're also aware that we have many medical professionals in our congregation who might be interested in a medical mission. LifeJourney is part of a small denomination called the Metropolitan Community Churches (MCC). Like many denominations, MCC is struggling. MCC's struggles do **not** adversely affect us at LifeJourney, but we want our members to be aware of the financial and organizational challenges MCC is facing.

MCC's General Conference will occur in early July. Votes will be held to elect a new Moderator, a new Governing Board, and to consider organizational restructuring.

At LifeJourney's last Congregational Meeting, members asked our Board of Directors questions about the viability of MCC and whether we should remain part of it. The Board is monitoring the situation and the results of the upcoming Gener-



In this course, we will take a deep dive into what it means to be a follower of Jesus, experiment with different ways of praying and engaging the Bible, explore what it means to be part of a church community, and make some wonderful new friends in the process! As an added bonus, once you've completed this course, you're eligible to become a voting member of LifeJourney if you wish.

Homosexuality and the Bible

If someone asked you to explain how the Bible affirms gay people, would you be able to confidently answer? If they claimed Romans 1 or the story of Sodom condemns gay people, would you be equipped to respond? Are you able to explain the five most powerful affirming passages in the Bible and why they're so important? By the end of this course, you will be! Pastor Jeff will teach this course drawing on his book The Children Are Free, which has sold thousands upon thousands of copies and been translated into seven languages.

Spiritual Principles for Dating

Relationships are sacred and, thus, should be formed with great care and intentionality. We owe it to ourselves and the people we date to grapple with critical questions like: What are the most common mistakes people make in dating? What kind of person should I be looking for? How am I preparing myself to be a great partner? What kind of courtship process do I feel led to follow? How soon should we move in together? How soon should we have sex- or should we wait? We won't all reach the same conclusions. The goal will be to help each of us figure out the best answers for ourselves, while integrating God and spiritual values into the dating process.

Hospitality Enhancements The Hospitality Ministry is hard at work enhancing our food

The Hospitality Ministry is hard at work enhancing our food and beverage offerings at church. Here's what's happening:

- Beverage Fridge: The vending machine has been transitioned from an outside company to a compact beverage fridge. This change should improve quality control and selections, while supporting future enhancements within the ministry. Beverage may be purchased on the honor system for \$1. (Please place money in the collection box.) Additionally, we'll continue to serve our free coffee and juices before and after service.
- Reverse Osmosis Filtration: To ensure we have great tasting water and coffee, a local company is installing a reverse osmosis system to improve the water supply to the kitchen.
- Signature Coffee Roast: In July, they will begin offering coffee sourced from a local roaster. This supplier is helping to create a signature "LifeJourney" blend to enhance the taste of our coffee, which will continue to be free.
