Construction Progress Report

Right now it feels like hurry up and wait, but that's not uncommon in construction. Here's where our three projects stand.

- New Restrooms: The state has required us to prepare a few additional engineering drawings before we can begin the rebuild process. Those drawings will be submitted this week, then the state will probably take a few weeks to review before greenlighting the rebuild. Meanwhile the restroom demo work and plumbing rough-in are proceeding. (See photos.)
- Exterior Siding: We ordered custom colors for the siding to get the look we want. The manufacturer has a factory backlog, so the custom siding won't be delivered until early August. We figure it's better to get it right than to get it quick. Demolition work for the siding is scheduled to begin July 29.
- Parking Lot Resurface: Parking lot work will begin after the siding is installed, so we don't have heavy truck traffic on the new asphalt.

MCC Denomination Update

LifeJourney is part of a small denomination called the Metropolitan Community Churches (MCC). Like many denominations, MCC is struggling. MCC's struggles do not adversely affect us at LifeJourney, but we want our members to be aware of the financial and organizational challenges MCC is facing.

MCC's General Conference will occur this week. Votes will be held to elect a new Moderator, a new Governing Board, and to consider organizational restructuring.

At LifeJourney's last Congregational Meeting, members asked our Board of Directors questions about the viability of MCC and whether we should remain part of it. The Board is monitoring the situation and the results of this week's General

Hospitality Enhancements The Hospitality Ministry is hard at work enhancing our food

and beverage offerings at church. Here's what's happening:

- Beverage Fridge: The vending machine has been transitioned from an outside company to a compact beverage fridge. This change should improve quality control and selections, while supporting future enhancements within the ministry. Beverages may be purchased on the honor system for \$1. (Please place money in the collection box.) Additionally, we'll continue to serve our free coffee and juices before and after service.
- Reverse Osmosis Filtration: To ensure we have great tasting water and coffee, we have installed a reverse osmosis system to improve the water supply to the kitchen.
- Signature Coffee Roast: In July, we will begin offering coffee sourced from a local roaster. This supplier is helping to create a signature "LifeJourney" blend to enhance the taste of our coffee, which will continue to be free.
