Worship As Healing

Mondays at 7:00 pm beginning Sept. 10, four weeks. Led by Pastor Jason Powell.

Course Description: Worship offers a portal to the healing dimensions of Spirit not ordinarily accessed by our everyday waking consciousness. Through worship, we may be healed and become conduits for healing—spiritual, physical, mental, emotional, and social healing. In this course, we'll explore some of the ancient spiritual understandings of worship as related to the Jewish feasts. The first class is on the night of Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year worship festival, which symbolizes a time of great spiritual power for creative change and new beginnings.

Financial Peace University

Course Description: Never worry about money again! This course will help you take control of your money, plan for your future, and transform your life.
