### Coming Soon in December

LifeJourney will launch *Dinner Church*—worship around the dinner table in Fountain Square. Every Thursday, starting the week after Thanksgiving, share in a potluck meal centered around the eucharist. Dinner begins at 6:30 pm, but the doors open by 6:00 pm for those who wish to prepare food and fellowship together.

Each week there will be a reading from the Narrative Lectionary, followed by an open discussion about the text around the table. All are welcome at the table, even our children! The message is short and surrounded by reflective moments that children can participate in. The setting is reflective, but informal and relaxed. The meal provides the space for adults to have deeper conversations.
