

Beginning this Thursday

This Thursday, LifeJourney will launch Dinner Church! Located in Fountain Square, dinner is centered around the Eucharist. Gather around the table for fellowship, discussion, and communion. The main dish is provided and you're welcome to bring a side dish if you like. Dinner begins at 6:30 pm, but the doors open by 6:00 pm for those who wish to prepare food and fellowship together.

Each week there will be a reading from the Narrative Lectionary, a 5-10 minute discussion starter, and open discussion about the text around the table. The setting is reflective, but informal. Children are welcome, along with the noise of laughter and side conversations they will inevitably bring. This is a space of generous orthodoxy, where all beliefs are honored and respected.

Consecration of the Elements

Proclamation of our Faith: Christ has died, Christ has risen, Christ is here now, and Christ will come again. Alleluia!

Distribution of the Elements

If this is your first time with us: You are welcome to receive Holy Communion (or simply observe). You can take Communion alone, or with friends or family. Ushers will release rows and direct you to a server. The server will offer you the wafer dipped in juice with a prayer. After receiving the elements, return to your seat by the side aisle. If you would like to receive Communion but are unable to come forward, please notify an usher.

The retreat begins on December 17 at 4:00 PM with a short devotional at Fatima House and ends December 18 at 6 PM with a brief discussion over coffee at Starbucks.
