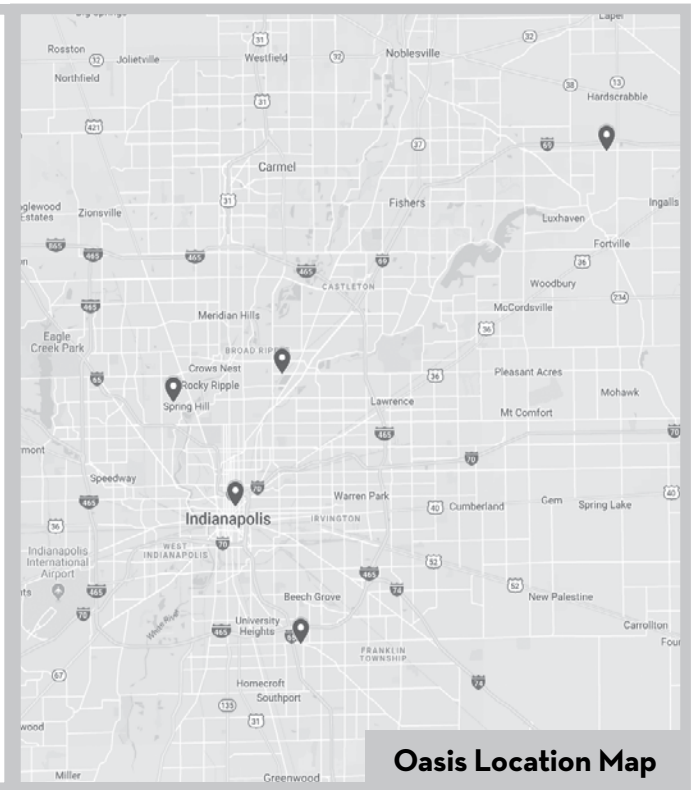

Board Election Notice

At our 2019 Annual Congregational Meeting, we will elect three members to our Board of Directors, each for a three-year term. Those positions have been filled by Sarah Kaminski, Nancy Duncan, and Allen Archibald. Allen and Nancy are willing to stand for reelection, but Sarah is ready for a rest after 12 years of faithful service!

Under our Bylaws, the Board is responsible for creating a Nominating Committee before each election to ensure at least one outstanding candidate is available for each position. The Bylaws provide that the Nominating Committee shall consist of the Senior Pastor, the Vice Moderator of the Board (Gene Parker), and two other church leaders who are not Board members. When selecting those two additional members of the Nominating Committee, the Board looks for leaders who know lots of people within the church and have not served on the Committee recently, so as to promote diversity of perspectives.

The Nominating Committee will canvass for interest, review all individuals who express interest, then prepare nominations. To stand for election, you must be a church member for at least 6 months, be regular in worship attendance, and be a regular giver. Board members are expected to attend regular monthly meetings (second Tuesday evening of each month) and to serve in various functions of church governance. Important qualities include: spiritual depth, collegial attitude, and strategic thinking.

Will You Help Us Seal The Deal?

In order to secure a capital improvements loan to upgrade our restrooms, repave our parking lot, and replace siding on our building, the bank has told us our giving for 2018 must equal or exceed \$490,000. Recent substantial increases in weekly giving, if sustained, will get us very close to that goal, but likely leave us a tad short since it took a few weeks for the increases to kick in.

To make sure we meet the year-end number set by the bank, we're inviting those who can to consider making a one-time year-end lump sum contribution. Those contributions will not only ensure we meet the bank's number, but also be applied to the restroom renovation, thereby reducing the amount we have to borrow! We're hoping to raise \$14,000 in year-end gifts. Gifts of any amount are welcome, but we especially need several large gifts of \$500, \$1,000, and \$2,000.

Every dollar donated now will save us \$1.65 in interest charges over the life of the loan, almost doubling the impact of your donation!
