What Will You Give Up For Lent? How 'bout Your Pants?

Many of us come from church traditions that observe the 40 Days of Lent, a time for reflection and preparation for Easter. Lent mirrors the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness fasting, praying, and reflecting in preparation for his ministry. Many of us are in the habit of giving up something for Lent, as a way of imitating Jesus' fasting.

This year, our church's Local Outreach Board would like to propose a novel way of marking Lent. For Lent this year, would you be willing to give up a pair of pants (or two or three) for the homeless? Our goal is to collect 40 pairs of pants—one pair for each day of Lent. Our hope is that we can reach and exceed that goal! Lent starts this Wednesday.

We need men's and women's pants in all sizes. They need not be new. As long as they are still intact and wearable, they will serve their purpose. Take a look through your closet and prayerfully consider what you feel led to give up. Bring your pants to church any Sunday during Lent and place them on top of the bin next to the Welcome Desk.

For the homeless, pants are always in short supply. They can't wash their clothes, so they just wear them till they wear out. Your Lenten sacrifice will make somebody else's life better.

If you would like to receive Communion but are unable to come forward, please notify an usher. **Gluten free** communion wafers are now available, upon request for those with dietary restrictions.

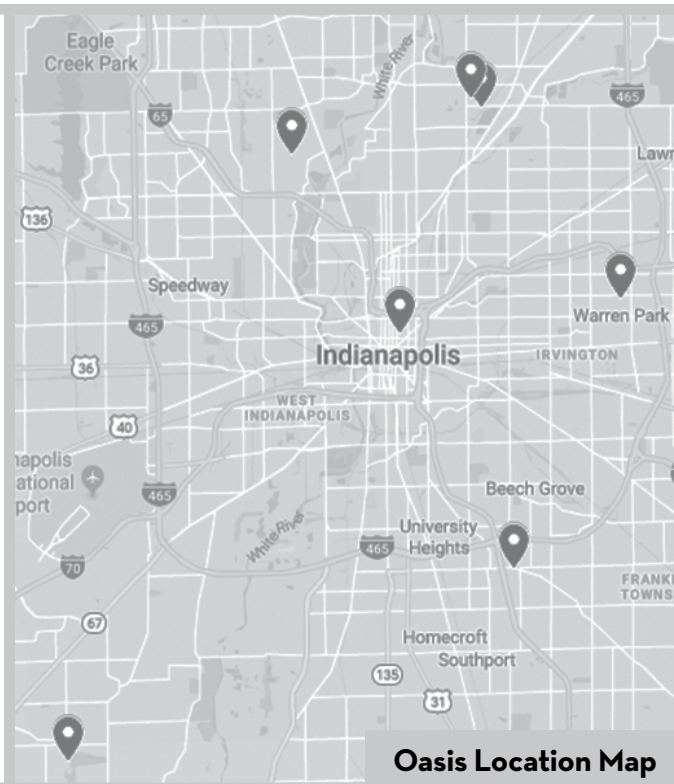

Cleanina Crew: Meeting Rooms



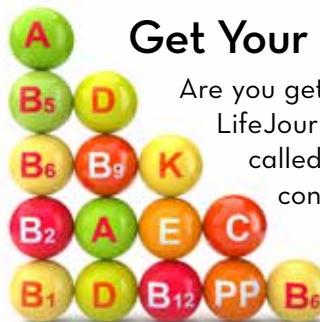
