Southside Oasis Invites You Out





On October 4 - 5, the CUSEN Network will be gathering at Eternal Joy MCC in Dayton, OH. Come for the weekend as MCC celebrates 50 years!

Friday evening includes a dinner, prayer, and music. Saturday includes a worship seminar, updates from MCC's recent General Conference (not to mention breakfast, lunch, worship and communion together). MCC's newly elected Moderator, Rev. Elder Cecilia Eggleston, will be present as well as one of the denominational Elders.

The Silent Prayer Retreat will be hosted at Fatima Retreat House on 56th Street (just down the street from the church). It is local, so travel will be minimal. *Impact can be maximal!*

The retreat includes Sunday dinner, then breakfast and lunch on Monday. The time together will conclude with an afternoon devotional and then going out for coffee together Monday, late afternoon, for a debrief and discussion. The cost is \$72 per person. This price includes meals (excludes coffee outing). Paid reservations must be submitted by October 1.

Register Now Fall Discipleship Courses!

Discipleship 101/102

Thursdays from 7:00 - 8:30 pm (7 wks), bracketed by two Saturday Retreats, Sept. 14 & Nov. 23, each from 9:30 - 3:30 pm. Teacher: Pastor David Zier. Registration Fee: \$40

This is our flagship course that we encourage everyone in our congregation to take at one point or another. In this course, we will take a deep dive into what it means to be a follower of Jesus, experiment with different ways of praying and engaging the Bible, explore what it means to be part of a church community, and make some wonderful new friends in the process! As an added bonus, once you've completed this course, you're eligible to become a voting member of LifeJourney if you wish.

Monastic Habits for Everyday Life

Thursdays from 6:30 - 8:00 pm, Oct. 10 - Nov. 21. Teacher: Pastor Chris Edwards. Registration fee \$20.

Learn how monastic practices can be integrated into the everyday life of the modern Christian. These daily habits can enrich your spiritual life and guide you toward a closer walk with Christ. We will cover topics like the liturgical calendar, lectionaries, Lectio Divina, centering prayer, prayer beads, the Daily Examen, labyrinths, retreat, holy wandering, anamcharas/soul friends, and much more. Discussions will focus on how you can adapt these practices to your own busy life. Each session will include guided practice through one of the covered habits. In addition to serving as our Family Life Minister, Pastor Chris is also a member of a dispersed monastic community with the Celtic Church.

Jesus and Politics

Wednesdays from 7:00 - 8:30 pm, Sept. 18 - Nov. 6. Teacher: Pastor Jeff Miner. Registration fee \$20.

We will explore how Jesus dealt with hot political issues in his time and consider how our faith informs our position on a variety of hot-button contemporary issues like prolife or prochoice, immigration, gun policy, taxation/government spending/deficits, racism and multiculturalism, environment, Republican or Democrat or beyond. We will explore these issues from all viewpoints, looking at the Scriptures relevant to each issue. The goal is not to all agree on the "right" answers, but to help each of us grow our own understanding, while engaging in open, honest, loving conversations.

Registrants covenant to attend all sessions unless ill or out of town. Fees are listed above in the course description and will be collected at the first class meeting, but scholarships are readily available and may be requested on the response form to the right.
